It was brilliant to see all of the children dressed as evacuees whilst we listened to old war songs, wrote postcards home, filled in identity labels and shared artefacts from the war, such as gas masks and suitcases. It was a fantastic day and a great way to kick off our topic!



Pupil Success

On Sunday, Edward from Darwin competed in the regional gymnastics grade qualifier in Maidstone. It was his first big competition for boys from gym clubs across the south east who are 9 years old. He finished 6th overall which is an excellent result for a boy who is a year younger than most of the other competitors! He has now qualified for the National Grades Competition and will represent the South East Region in Telford this coming October. Unauthorised Absence from School

Just to remind parents/carers that if you take your child/ren out of school without authority for five or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), you will be liable to receive a penalty notice.

Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/ carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices. Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.
