Higgins Partnership

On Tuesday, the Pupil Leaders took part in interviews with representatives from the Higgins

Partnership. The children asked questions on behalf of the community. We all learned a lot about the development known as "Botanical Place". Many thanks to the Higgins Partnership for delivering two assemblies to the children. Here is what we learnt:

130 people work at the site at the moment.

They will be planting trees and small bushes to go in the central area between two buildings known as "The Cut".

There will be seating in this central area for use by the whole community.

There are 11 units planned as shops but they do not know yet what type of shops.

There is a new library planned which will front onto the Old Woking Road.

The highest part of the construction is 90 feet high and there are 8 levels.

They took over the project in August 2022.

They started planning in 2021 for completion in 2025 and predict the completion of the project in Spring 2025.

There will be 1, 2 and 3 bedroom flats for 197 residents aged over 55.

There will be a small swimming pool located in the residents leisure area.

There will definitely be a coffee shop. There will be between 70-80 flats in total.

Unauthorised Absence from School

Just to remind parents/carers that if you take your child/ren out of school without authority for five or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), you will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices. Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.
