#### **International Day**

Year 3 enjoyed learning about South Africa, Tanzania and Morocco, as part of International Day. From spices, to storytelling, to biltong; the children were able to experience and immerse themselves in each of these African countries. A special thank you goes out to the Anderson family in Eden class, for providing flags and delicious, traditional South African delicacies, which the children loved tasting!

Year 4 started the day by creating our own WBJS passports and then 'visited' the Americas. The students had an opportunity to learn about life in Washington DC (USA) from Mr Zlatkov, who was covering Shakespeare class and had recently returned from



living and working in the country. We then made Samba music in Darwin class to get a feel of the Brazilian culture and created colourful carnival masks in Nightingale class, immersing themselves in the Caribbean Island experience. We were fortunate enough to have a special guest Ms Chergia, who showed us Indonesian shadow puppets and inspired us to create our own. We also heard about Slovenia from Mr Charles-Jones and his mum, and listened to The Gruffalo Child translated into Slovene. Lastly, Years 3 and 5 were entertained with a French rendition of Peppa Pig by Mrs Bensberg. The whole school were also entertained by a wonderful French/English production of 'Chasse au Tresor' by the Joy4kids theatre company. #### **Science Expo**

We are delighted to return to a very successful Science Expo. This year, we have linked our topic to TIME – the theme of the British Science week 2024. The aim of the 'Expo' is to raise awareness of how we can work scientifically and increase the enjoyment of the subject in school and at home. As part of the children's home learning for the next three school weeks, each child is asked to research a scientific concept linked to the theme TIME. From this, they will produce a model or demonstration, along with an accompanying poster or A4 information sheet explaining the science behind their project and a list of resources used in research of the topic. You may help your child with this home project, but keep in mind that they must understand what the scientific concept is and be able to answer questions about their project. Assistance will also be given in school. We politely ask that models are a reasonable size, do not create too much mess, and that all items are taken home at the end of the presentation. The children are expected to bring their complete work to school on Monday 25 March and present it to their class. The children will be presenting their models to their class parents on Tuesday 26 March in their classrooms at 2:30pm.

#### Year 5 Swimming: Focus of the week:

Group 1: Faces in water, leg kicks and flotation

Group 2: Floating on back and front, single front crawl with float

Group 3: Backstroke, floating and arm and kicking techniques

Group 4: Dolphin stroke, breathing

Group 5: Breast stroke and front crawl breathing with arm pull.

#### **Unauthorised Absence from School**

Just to remind parents/carers that if you take your child/ren out of school without authority for five or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), you will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices. Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.
