What you need to bring...

Hooke Court 'What to pack' list

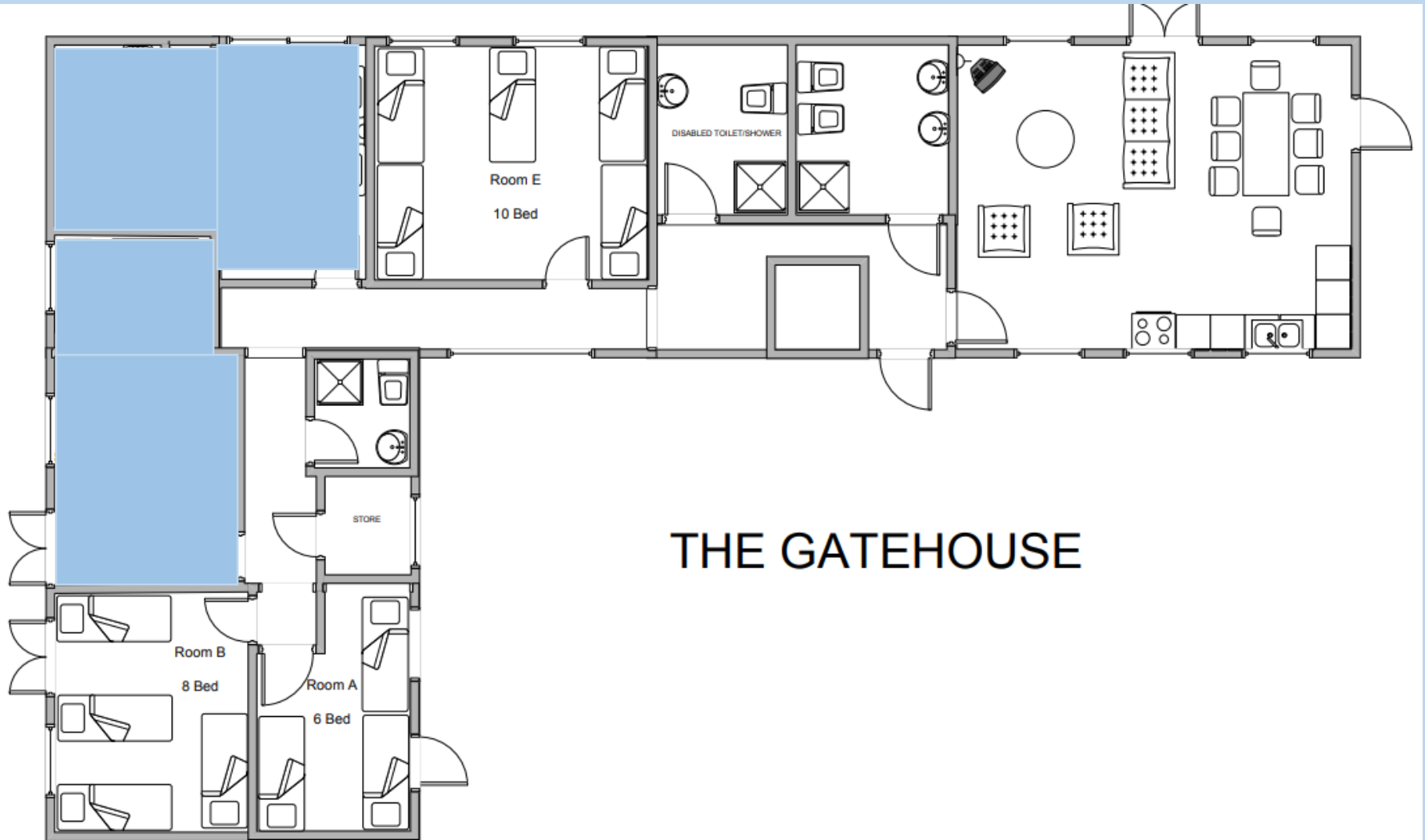
- At least FOUR pairs of trousers – jogging bottoms best for activities – no jeans
- Range of tops – T shirts (short and long sleeved – please no crop tops)
- AT LEAST 3 Jumpers/Fleeces
- Waterproof and warm coat (can be the same thing, or a warm coat with thinner waterproof to wear on top).
- One pair of wellies/walking boots (with thick, warm socks – if it is cold, wellies will not keep your feet warm)
- One pair of trainers that can be worn outside
- Shoes to wear indoors only
- Pyjamas or nightdress and dressing gown
- Underwear – enough!
- Socks – lots of!
- Gloves, Hat and Scarf - ESSENTIAL
- Bath Towel
- Toiletries (in a wash bag, no aerosols)
 - soap
 - flannel
 - toothbrush and toothpaste
 - shampoo (if necessary)
- Hairbrush/comb
- Small Teddy!
- Named water bottle
- Large named black bin liner (for dirty clothes)
- Named purse with max £5 pocket money (**not a note, silver coins preferred**)

Please ensure all clothing is CLEARLY NAMED!

Medication

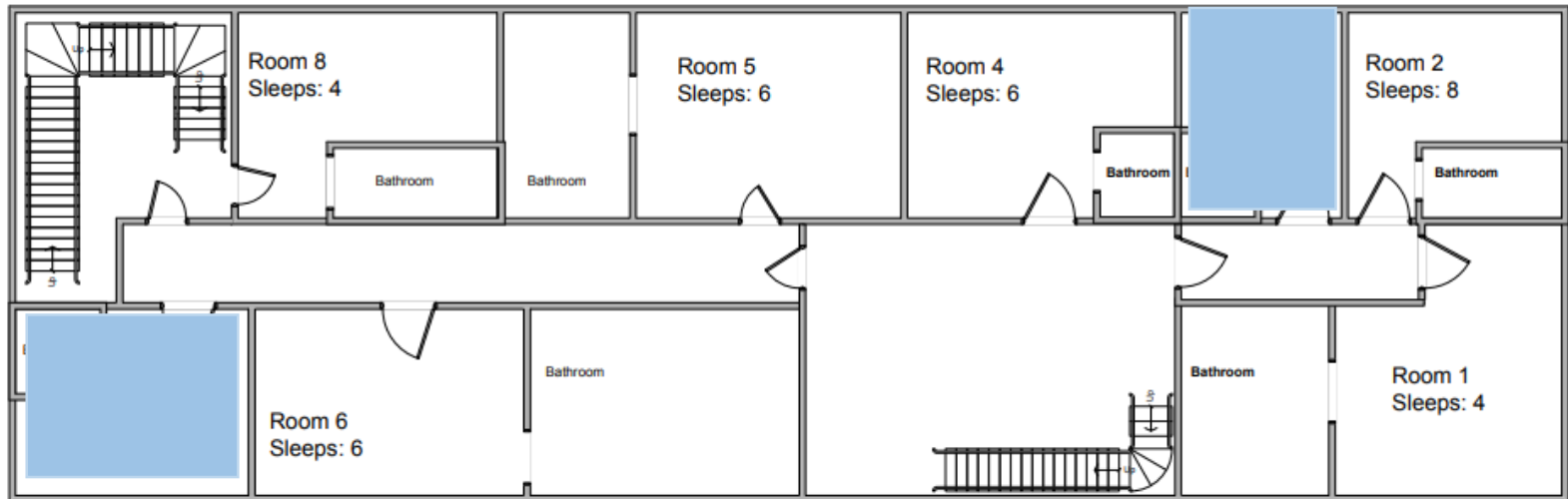
- If applicable, any named medicines required for the duration with full dosage instructions, **all medicines must be in original packaging with the chemist dispensing label if prescription medication.**
- Travel sickness medication must be taken at the required time before we leave school.
- Any medication needed for the journey home must be clearly labelled, with required timings of when to take medication.
- The medical form has already gone home and should have been returned.

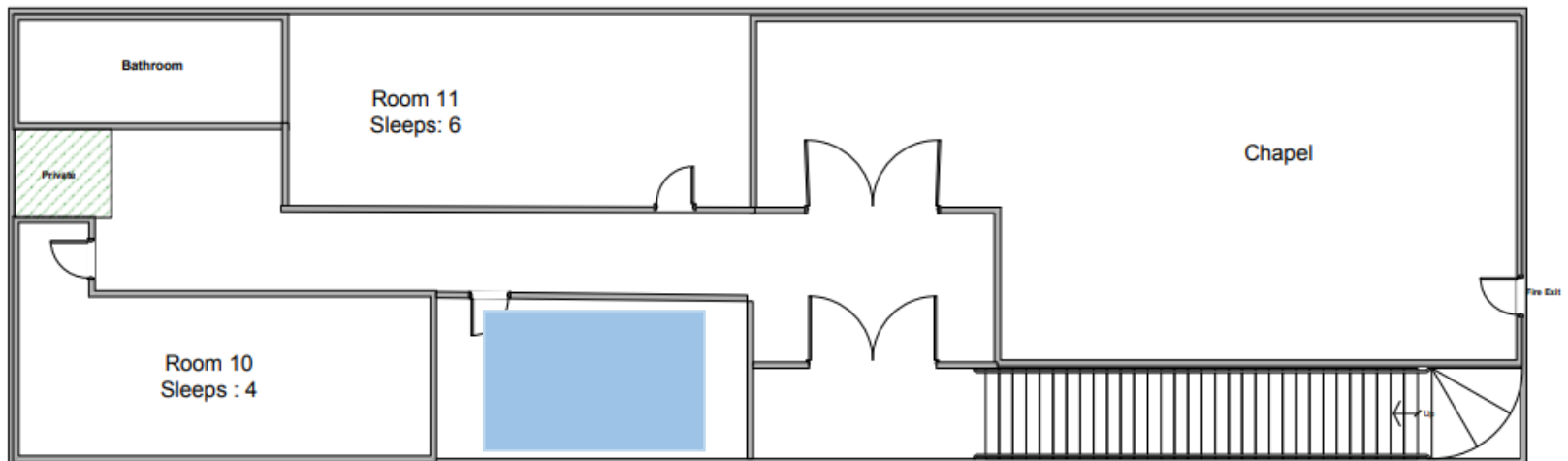


Accommodation

The First Floor

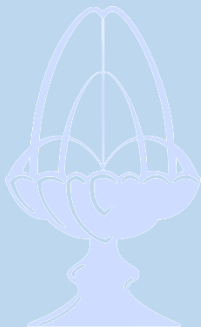

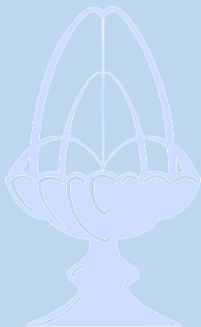
Timings: Leaving

- Parents must stay within the designated waiting area.



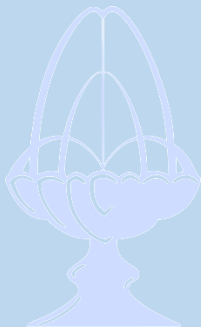
Timings: Returning
