All entries need to be submitted to Mrs Turitto in Year 5 Franklin class by Friday 28th March 2025.

The entries will be shortlisted for the best 5 entries to be sent to British Science Week organisers.

Every participant will receive 10 house points and your work will be displayed in school and on the school website.

You can work in a group, all members and their age needs to be mentioned at the back on the poster.

Your age

Year group

If you submit your work as a group, name all the participants.

Categories that include our school age are:

- **INFANT (age 5-8) Year groups 1-3**
- **JUNIOR (age 8-11) Year groups 4-6**

We wish that everyone could be a winner, but we only have a limited number of prizes. So, here's the lowdown on what the judges will be looking for:

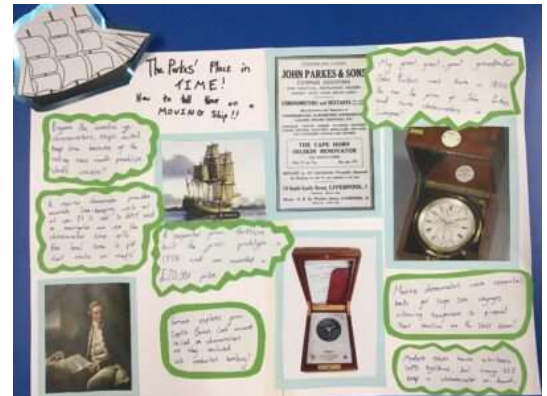
- **Creativity in approach** – Innovative angle on the content or creative interpretation of the theme – don't be afraid to think outside the box
