You may feel angry, distracted, frustrated, challenged, confused or uncomfortable.



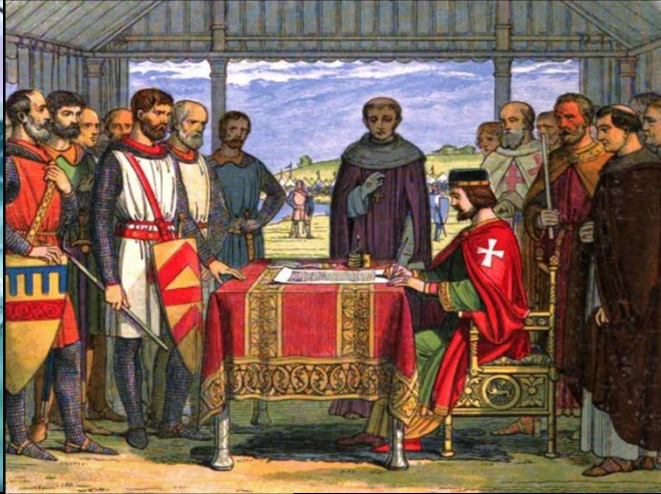

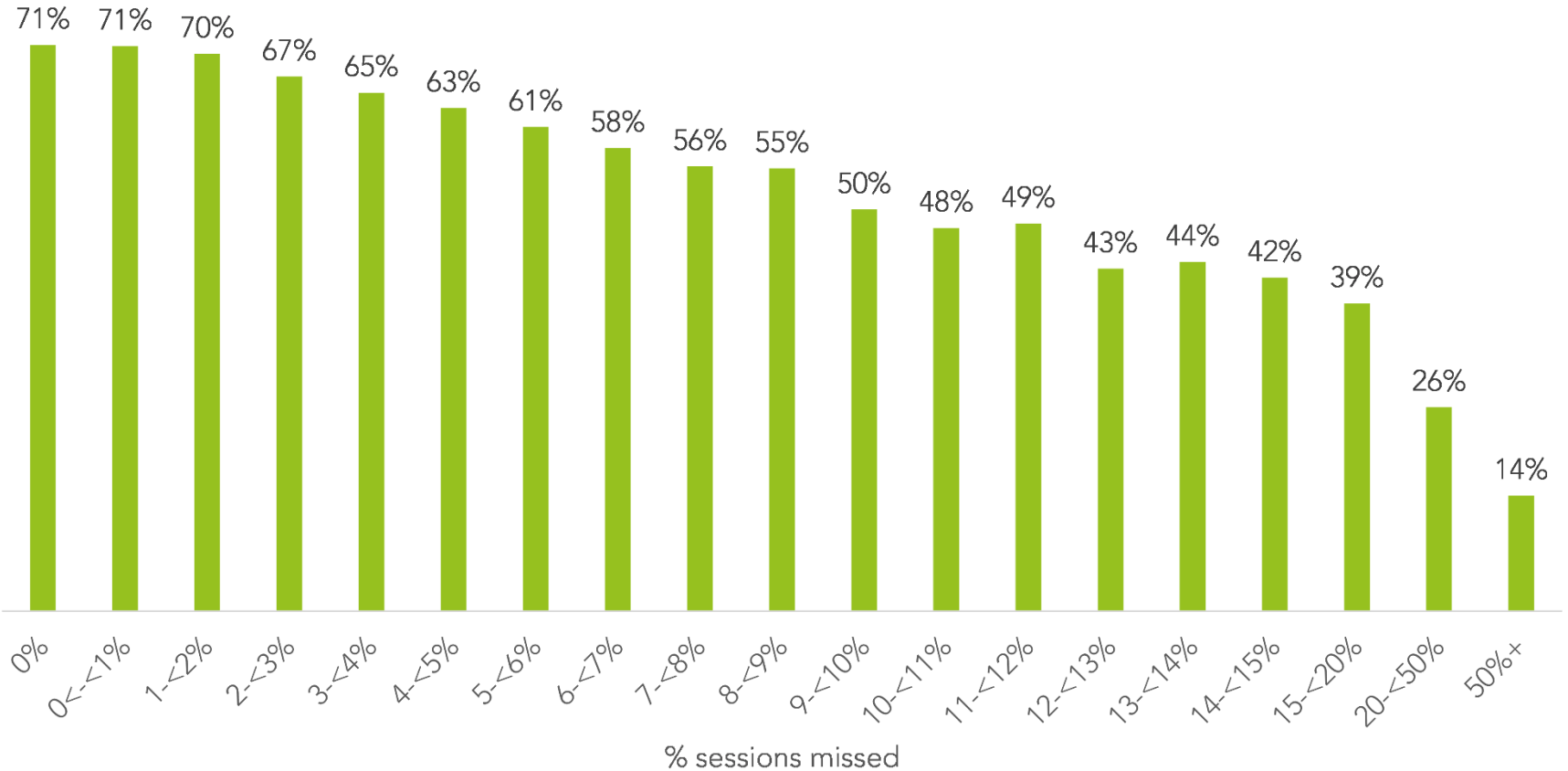
