The grids will guide you in choosing tasks, which might include written tasks, cooking, art, computing, maths and outdoor experiences. Homework books will be given out on Thursdays and must be handed in the following Tuesday. All work must be recorded in homework books. Parents/carers must date and sign when activities have been completed.</p>	<p>Read at least 3 times a week. Access TTRS for times table practise or NumBots to speed up number skills. Carry out quizzes for completed reading books on Accelerated Reader. If your child has access to Nessy, regular spelling and reading practise should be happening at home.</p>	<p>Presentation in homework books should reflect the same standards as in schoolbooks in the classroom; all work completed in your homework book should be your personal best.</p>
