We also have an incremental increase each year with the number of nights away, starting with a one night residential in Year 4.

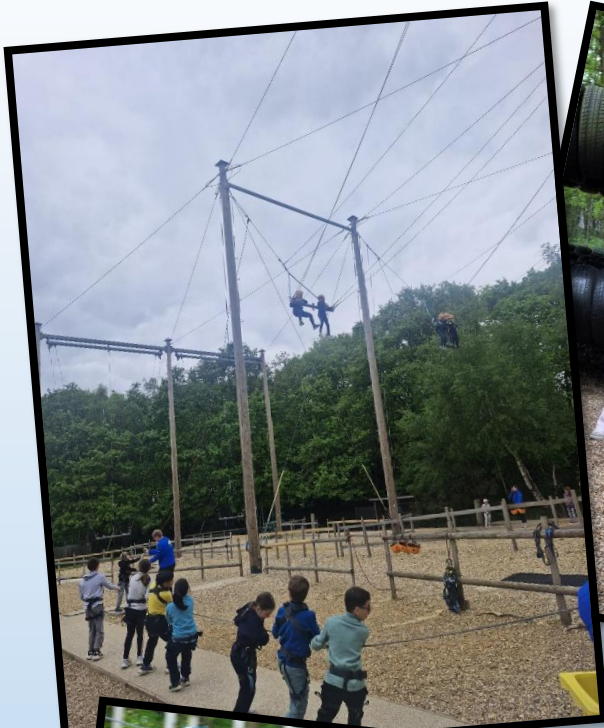

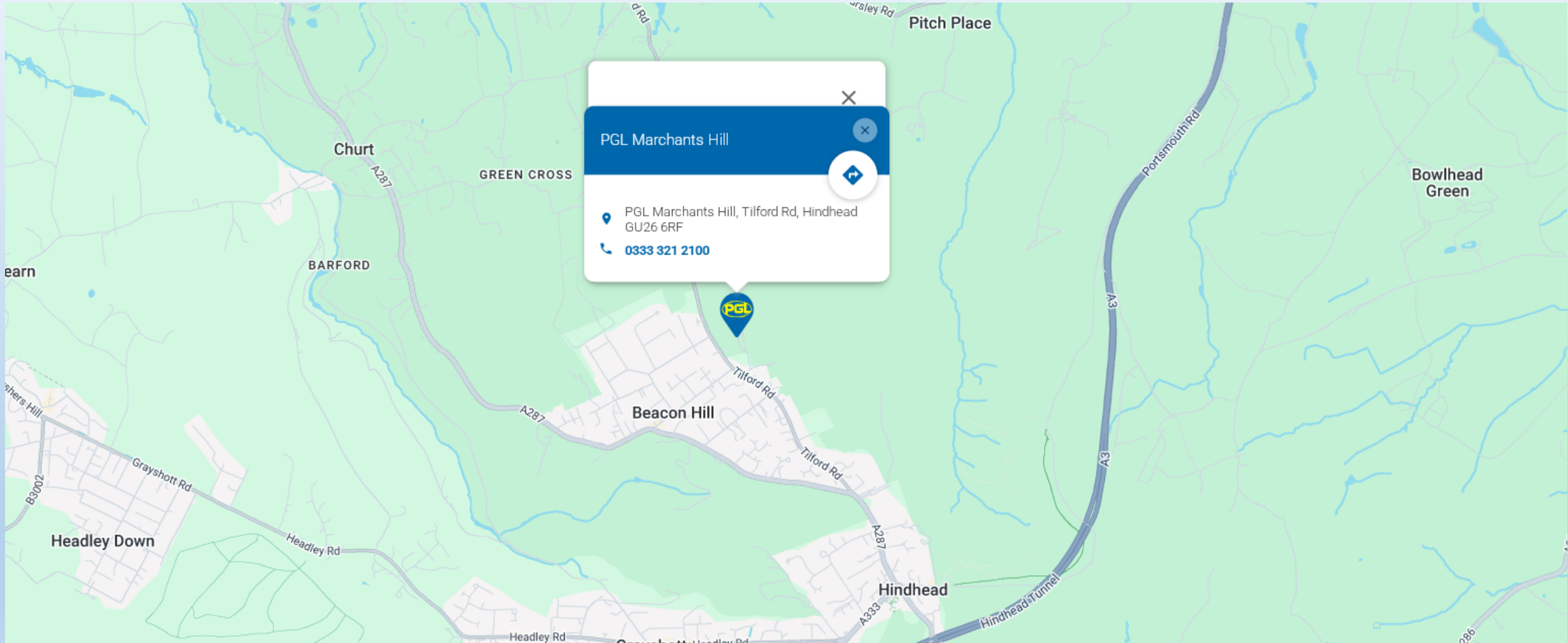
