Having a Go

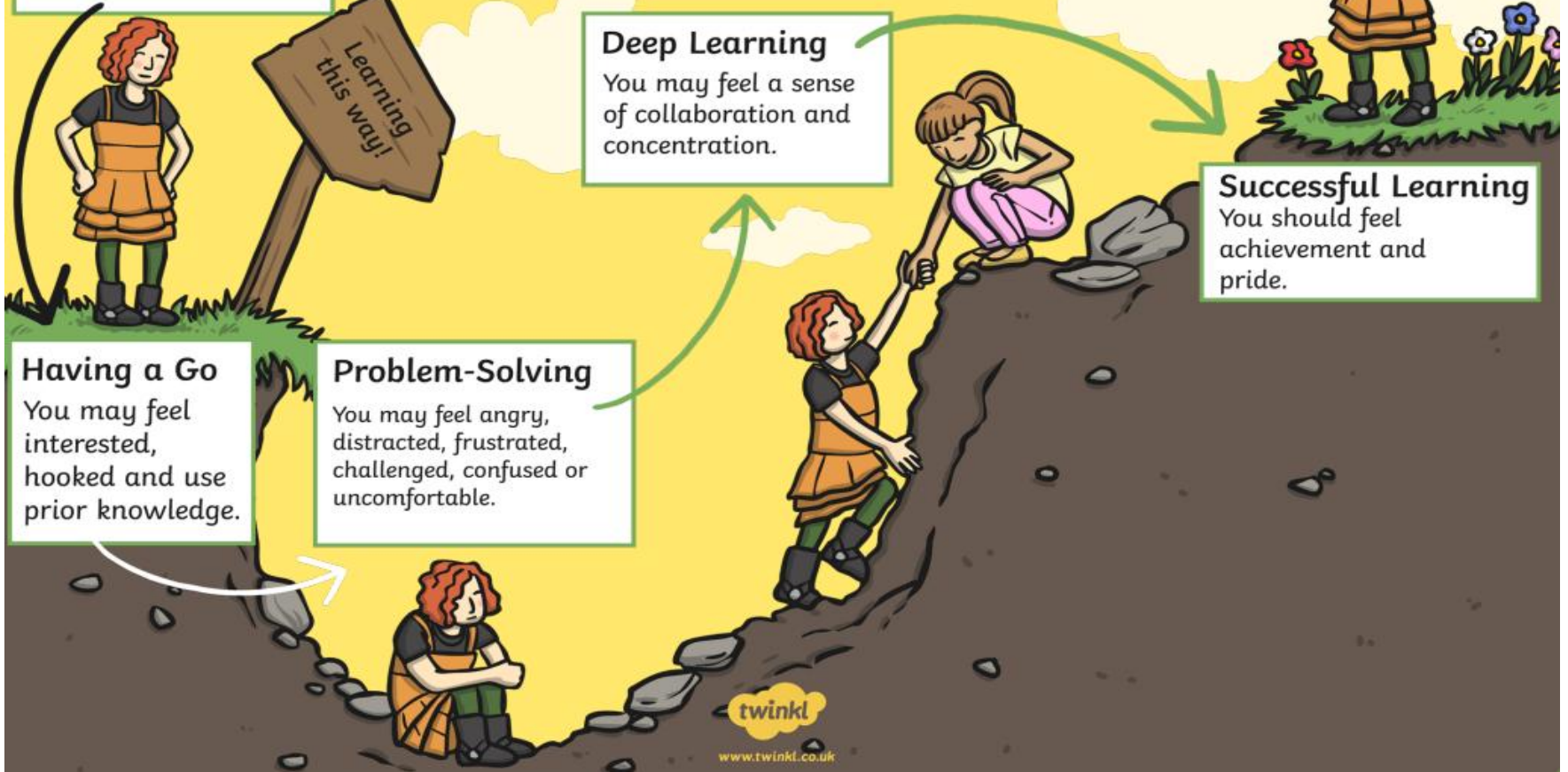
You may feel interested, hooked and use prior knowledge.

You should feel achievement and pride.



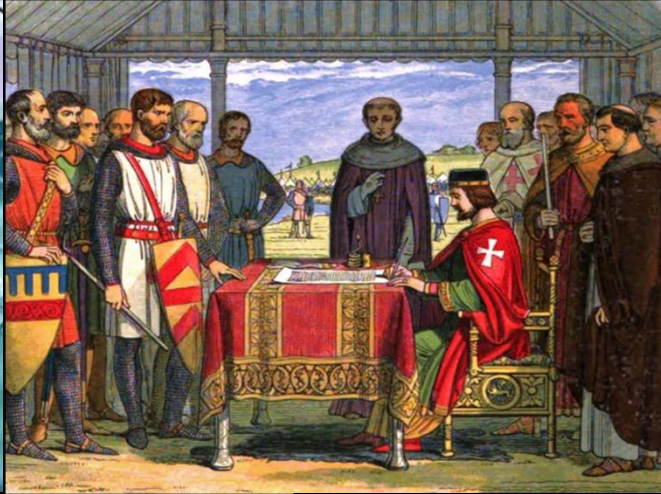

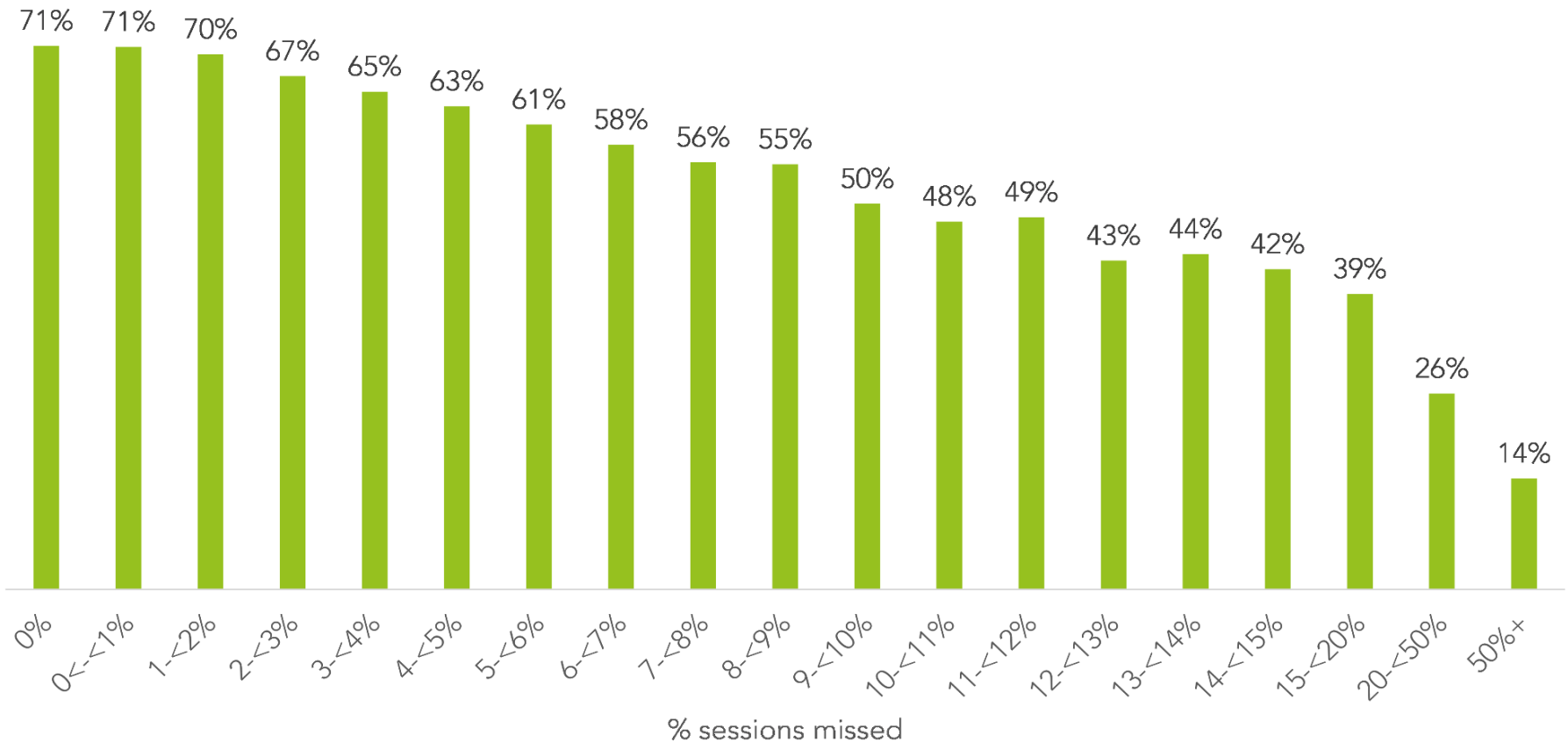
