Uniform List and Dress Code

As part of our commitment to keeping school uniform costs as affordable as possible, we are following the latest government guidance on school uniforms. This guidance states that schools should not require families to purchase more than three branded uniform items plus a school tie. To support this, the school will only make a limited number of branded items compulsory. This helps reduce costs for families while still maintaining a strong school identity.

However, parents and carers are welcome to purchase additional branded items if they wish. Any extra branded clothing offered by the school will remain optional and can be chosen according to personal preference.

We appreciate your support in ensuring that our uniform remains both practical and affordable for all families while continuing to promote a sense of pride and belonging within our school community.

• Navy polo shirt or T-shirt (with school logo optional) • Navy PE shorts • Navy tracksuit trousers • Tracksuit jacket (with school logo) • Navy or white base layer (top only) • Trainers	

Dress Code

Wearing of uniform

Uniform should be correctly worn both in and out of school, eg shirt tucked in and ties worn correctly.

Shoes must be work on non-sports kit days, not trainers

Jewellery

For the safety of children, no jewellery is permitted in school (except for medical or religious purposes)

Small stud earrings (one per ear) are permitted but children must be able to remove these independently for PE lessons. Parents will be contacted to come into school if a child is struggling to remove these independently. Children will not be able to take part in PE lessons if they are wearing earrings. Plasters should only be used to cover earrings as an emergency measure eg infection and this should have been communicated to the class teacher.

We strongly recommend that if your child wishes to have their ears pierced, that you arrange this at the very start of the summer holidays as this allows time for the six-week period of healing.

Make up and nail varnish/extensions

Make up, nail varnish, false nails and nail extensions may not be worn in school. Children will be asked to remove make up if they come into school wearing it.

Hair

Hair is to be neat and tidy at all times. No extreme haircuts, dyes or hair gel should be worn. Hair below collar length must be tied back in a tidy style using plain blue hair bands/clips/Alice-bands.

Ornate hair accessories are not permitted.

All hair should be clear of the eye line.
