

Activity	Description
Creative calligraphy	An exciting opportunity to learn how to write in calligraphy style and frame the writing afterwards for display at home!
Christmas decorations	Be creative with cross-stitch and make some decorations for your house or Christmas tree!
Photography	An opportunity to produce a PowerPoint portfolio of photographs taken with differing techniques from macro to wide angle. You will also have a chance to use online editing software and create your own watermark.
Clay pots	Take a trip back in time to Ancient Greece, and discover how they created works of art in the form of pottery!
Spanish	¡Hola! If you would like to learn an exciting new language, then Spanish class is for you! Looking at the basics; including numbers, colours and basic conversation!
Christmas stocking designing/making	There are so many lovely things associated with Christmas, but one of the nicest is the sight of a Christmas stocking hung by a warm fireplace. Design and make your own Christmas stocking that will fit just enough treats and goodies. A perfect, handmade gift to bring smiles on Christmas morning!
Festive Maths	For a fun and festive themed Maths experience – calculator quizzes, tangrams and geometric stars as well as 3D shapes – ‘Maths at all angles!’
Sewing	Get creative and design and make your own tote bag. We will be learning different textile and sewing styles as well as measuring, cutting, pinning and then stitching your bag together.
Dance	If you love to dance, bring your ballet, tap, jazz shoes or simply your bare feet. We will look at creating dances using different styles. You will be a part of “The Greatest Show.”
A play in a day	There’s no business like show business...! Fancy catching the acting bug? You will get the chance to develop your acting skills through focusing on your voice, movement, presence, confidence and performance; and yes, there will be some dressing up too!
Cracking Codes!	Can you crack a code? How many different types of code can you decipher? Can you create your own code? And once you have all these coding skills, we may need to practise a few other essential spy skills.
Castles in the Woodland	This will involve creating castle defences, catapults, decorating a wooden bow and arrow and capturing castle defences.
