

Examples of codes:

There loads of codes out there, but these are my favourite two:

The first is an example of a **Caesar Cipher** shift code (named after the Roman Emperor Julius Caesar as he apparently used it) with a key of 4 - the letters of the alphabet have been moved on 4 spaces. The top row are the letters you would normally write, the bottom row the code so HELLO = lipps when written in code.
